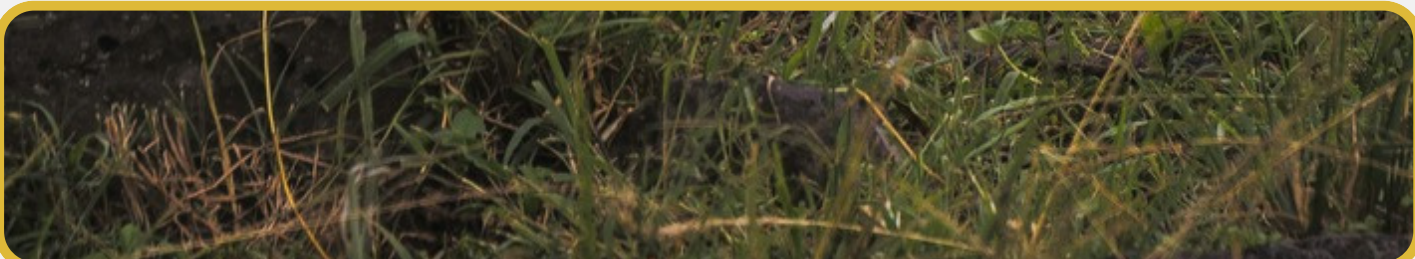

With the Bush to Beach Experience, the guide takes guests through two of Africa's most remarkable ecosystems, each offering a completely different perspective of the continent. The journey begins at Skukuza Rest Camp in the Kruger National Park, where days are spent exploring wildlife-rich landscapes in search of Africa's iconic species. Mornings start before sunrise, roads are lined with fresh animal tracks, and every game drive carries the anticipation of something unexpected.

Then the journey changes.

The safari roads give way to coastal tracks.
The sounds of the bush are replaced by the rhythm of the Indian Ocean.

The pace slows.
Shoes become optional.
The experience evolves from wildlife adventure into coastal exploration.

Together, these two worlds create a journey that feels balanced, diverse, and uniquely African.

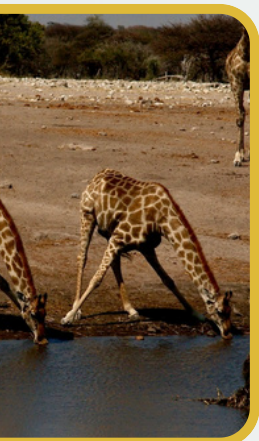

The Adventure Begins

The first half of the journey is dedicated to exploring the Kruger National Park through daily private safari experiences.

Guests travel from camp to camp, experiencing different regions of the park while immersing themselves in its ever-changing landscapes.

Highlights include:

- Scenic river systems
- One Bush braai experience hosted by your guide
- Camp-to-camp safari exploration

Kruger Accommodation

4 Nights

Accommodation throughout the first few nights are based within Kruger National Park rest camps.

While the camps themselves are simple and comfortable, *the true luxury of this safari lies in the amount of time spent immersed in the wilderness itself.*

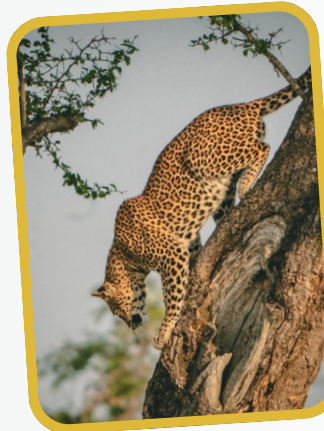
Guests can expect:

- Clean, self-catering, bungalow-style accommodation
- Access to camp restaurants, shops, and viewpoints
- Evenings surrounded by the sounds of the African bush
- Sunrise departures and relaxed evenings around camp after full safari days
- A braai (Local Dinner) prepared by your guide on one of the nights

Typical camps may include:

Camp selections remain flexible and are chosen based on availability, seasonal wildlife conditions, guest interest, and overall safari flow to ensure the best possible experience.



Ponta Malongane

The Shift

After days immersed in the bush, the journey shifts to the Mozambican coast, where the rhythm changes completely.

Ponta Malongane lies along a pristine stretch of coastline within the **protected Ponta do Ouro Partial Marine Reserve**.

Here, forest meets ocean, and life moves with the tides rather than tracks. This is the counterbalance to safari days, offering contrast, release, and a second ecosystem to explore.

The experience naturally shifts from land to sea, with time to slow down and take in the coastal surroundings.



What makes Ponta Malongane exceptional:

- Warm Indian Ocean waters and protected coral reef systems
- Rich marine life and diverse ocean activities
- A vibrant coastal atmosphere, with local restaurants, nightlife, and craft markets
- A distinct culture and cuisine, different to that of South Africa

- Two ocean-based activities per person, such as scuba diving or ocean safaris

Ponta Malongane Accommodation

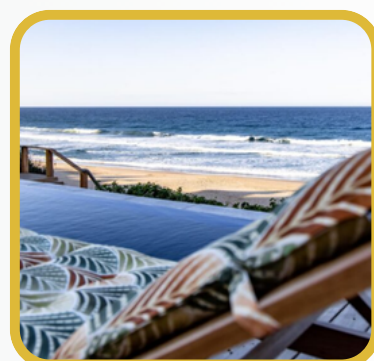
