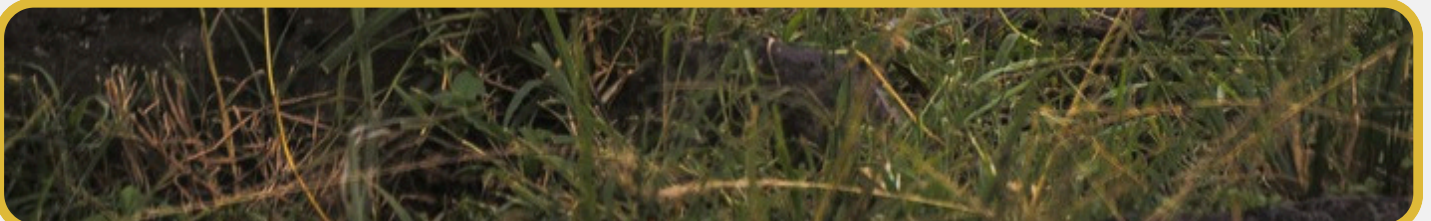

Each day is spent exploring the wildlife-rich Southern Kruger with your private guide before returning to the calm rhythm of Marloth Park each evening.

Unlike a moving overland safari, this experience allows guests to properly settle in.

There is no constant unpacking, no changing camps, and no feeling of being rushed from one destination to the next.

Instead, the safari naturally balances:

- immersive wildlife exploration,
- slow bush mornings,
- relaxed afternoons,
- and intimate evenings surrounded by nature.

The result is a safari that feels both adventurous and restorative.

Your days are spent tracking wildlife through the Kruger's untamed landscapes, while your evenings shift into a softer, slower atmosphere of comfort, stillness, and connection to the bush.

About the Kruger National Park

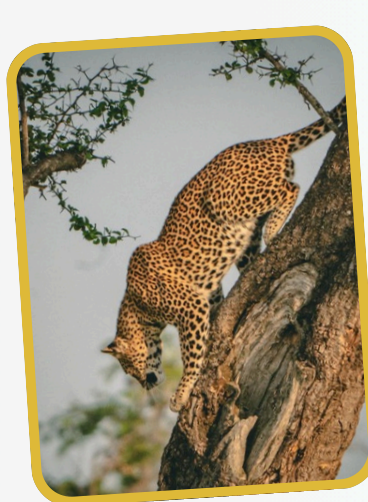

About Marloth Park

Bordering the Kruger National Park along the Crocodile River, Marloth Park offers a uniquely relaxed safari atmosphere where wildlife moves freely between homes, bushveld, and open spaces.

It is one of the few places where the safari experience continues even after returning from the park itself.

Guests can often expect to see:

- Zebra
- Giraffe
- Warthog
- Kudu
- Numerous bird species

wandering naturally through the area.

Its location also makes it an ideal base for exploring the southern Kruger while still enjoying restaurants, local shops, bush walks, and slower evenings between safari days.

Accommodation & Atmosphere

Guests stay at Kruger Eden Lodge, a thoughtfully designed bush retreat where comfort and nature exist side by side.

The atmosphere here is intentionally calm, intimate, and restorative.

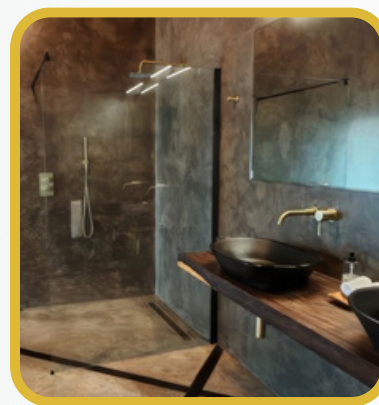
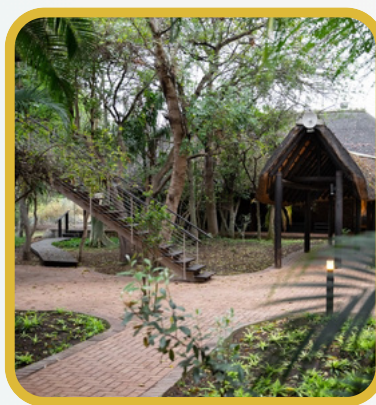
After full safari days, guests can unwind:

- on private terraces,

- or around the traditional boma fire.

The focus is not on excessive luxury, but rather on creating a comfortable and peaceful environment that allows guests to properly absorb the experience of the bush.



How the Safari Unfolds

Each morning begins with your private guide collecting your group before entering the Southern Kruger for the day's safari experience.

From there, the safari unfolds organically according to:

- wildlife movement,
- weather conditions,
- guest interests,
- and the natural rhythm of the bush.

Some days may revolve around predator activity and fast-paced sightings. Others may slow down around elephants at river crossings, scenic viewpoints, or long quiet moments observing wildlife behaviour.

The flexibility of a private safari allows the experience to remain immersive and personal throughout.

By late afternoon, guests return to Marloth Park where the pace shifts completely.

Evenings become slower, quieter, and more restorative as the bush atmosphere naturally takes over.

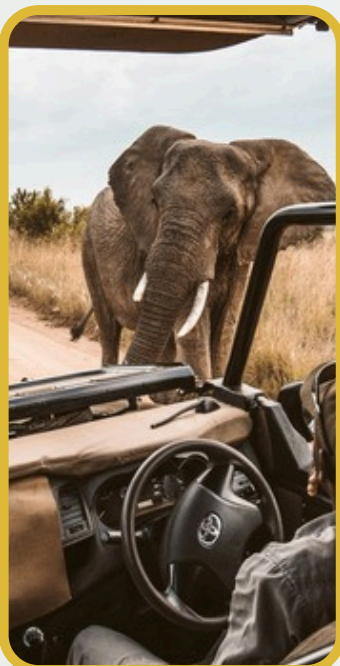
- **Deposit:** 50% on acceptance
