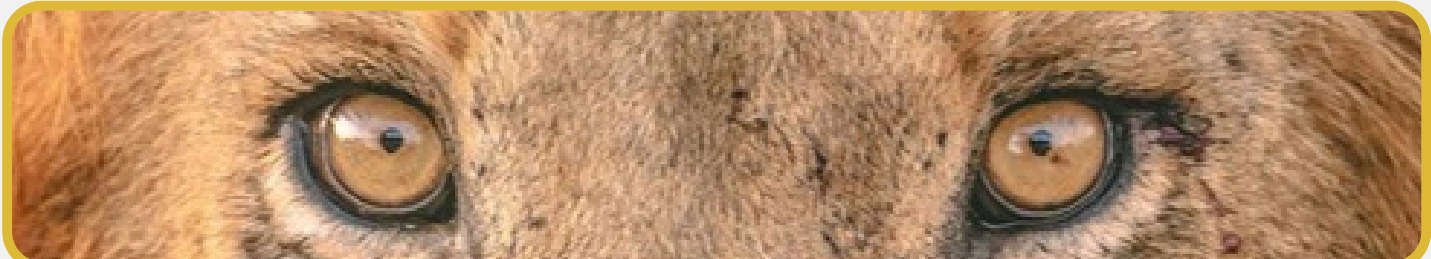

The Experience

The Marloth Overland Explorer ***combines the excitement of daily Kruger safaris with the comfort and ease of returning to the same bush retreat each evening.***

Rather than moving camp-to-camp through the Kruger, this safari is built around a more grounded rhythm. Guests spend their days exploring the wildlife-rich southern Kruger before returning to Marloth Park to relax, reconnect, and settle into the slower pace of the bush.

It creates a safari experience that feels immersive without feeling constantly on the move.

By evening, the atmosphere softens completely.

Wildlife wanders freely through Marloth Park, campfires begin to glow, and the sounds of the bush continue long after the safari vehicle has stopped moving.

About the Kruger National Park

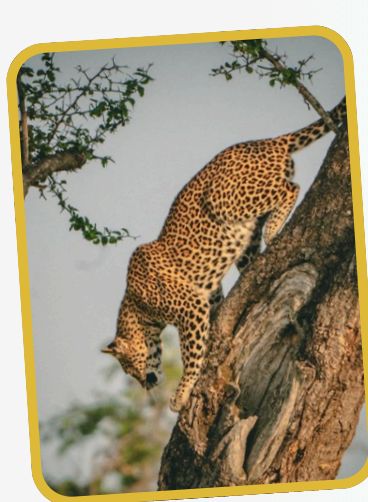
The Kruger National Park is widely regarded as one of Africa's premier safari regions, known for its exceptional wildlife density, diverse ecosystems, and strong predator activity.

Spanning nearly 20,000 km², the Kruger protects one of the continent's most important natural ecosystems and offers guests an authentic safari experience shaped by free-roaming wildlife and vast untouched landscapes.

- River systems attracting abundant wildlife

About Marloth Park

Bordering the Kruger National Park along the Crocodile River, Marloth Park offers a uniquely relaxed safari atmosphere where wildlife moves freely between homes, bushveld, and open spaces.

It is one of the few places where the safari experience continues even after returning from the park itself.

Guests can often expect to see:

- Zebra
- Giraffe
- Warthog
- Kudu
- Numerous bird species wandering naturally through the area.

Its location also makes it an ideal base for exploring the southern Kruger while still enjoying restaurants, local shops, bush walks, and slower evenings between safari days.

Accommodation & Atmosphere

Guests stay at Galago's Nest Bush Chalets, a relaxed and comfortable bush retreat designed around group travel and flexible living.

The atmosphere here is intentionally easygoing and social.

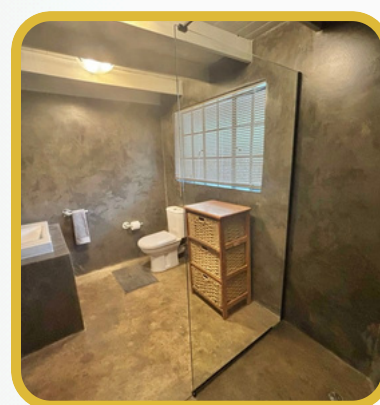
After full safari days, guests can spend their evenings:

How the Safari Unfolds

Each morning, your private guide collects your group before entering the Southern Kruger for the day's safari experience.

From there, the day naturally unfolds according to:

- Wildlife movement
- Seasonal conditions
- Guest interests
- Sightings and safari flow

No two days inside the Kruger ever feel the same.

Some mornings begin with lion tracks on the road before sunrise. Others may unfold around elephants crossing riverbeds, long giraffe encounters, or quiet moments watching birdlife at a waterhole.

The flexibility of a private safari allows the experience to adapt naturally rather than rushing between fixed stops.

Throughout the day, your guide incorporates scenic viewpoints, rest camp stops, and opportunities to pause and enjoy the landscapes at a relaxed pace.

By late afternoon, guests return to Marloth Park where the atmosphere shifts from exploration to relaxation.
