The Experience

The Kruger Overland is designed for travellers wanting to **experience the Kruger as a journey following the lead of a qualified guide rather than exploring a single destination.**

This is a safari built around movement, exploration, and time spent immersed in the wild.

Rather than returning to the same location each night, guests travel deeper into the Kruger with their private guide in an open safari vehicle, allowing the safari to naturally adapt to wildlife movement, seasonal conditions, and the rhythm of the bush itself.

What Defines This Safari

Unlike safaris centred around a single lodge or region, the Kruger Overland allows guests to experience the scale and diversity of the Kruger National Park firsthand.

Every transfer day becomes part of the safari itself.

The changing ecosystems, rivers, vegetation, and wildlife densities create a constantly shifting experience, making no two days feel the same.



Accommodation

Accommodation throughout the safari is based within Kruger National Park rest camps.

While the camps themselves are simple and comfortable, *the true luxury of this safari lies in the amount of time spent immersed in the wilderness itself.*

Guests can expect:

- Clean, self-catering, bungalow-style accommodation
- Access to camp restaurants, shops, and viewpoints
- Evenings surrounded by the sounds of the African bush
- Sunrise departures and relaxed evenings around camp after full safari days

Typical camps may include:

- Skukuza
- Lower Sabie
- Berg-en-Dal
- Olifants
- Mopani

Camp selections remain flexible and are chosen based on availability, seasonal wildlife conditions, guest interest, and overall safari flow to ensure the best possible experience.



How the Safari Unfolds

Each morning begins with a new stretch of wilderness waiting to be explored.

As the safari moves through the park, guests experience the gradual transitions between regions, from wildlife-rich Southern grasslands and river systems to quieter Northern landscapes filled with ancient trees, open plains, and remote wilderness.

Some days are built around long exploratory drives with frequent wildlife encounters and rest stop breaks along the way. Others may slow down around exceptional sightings, scenic viewpoints, or areas with high animal activity.

No two safaris unfold the same way.

The ever-changing nature of the Kruger is part of what makes this style of safari so rewarding.

Throughout the experience, your guide adapts routes and pacing according to:

- Wildlife movement
- Seasonal conditions
- Guest interests
- Safari flow and timing

This creates a safari that feels flexible, personal, and naturally immersive rather than rushed or overly structured.

Its extraordinary biodiversity, vast open ecosystems, and long-standing conservation legacy have made it one of the world's most respected safari regions.

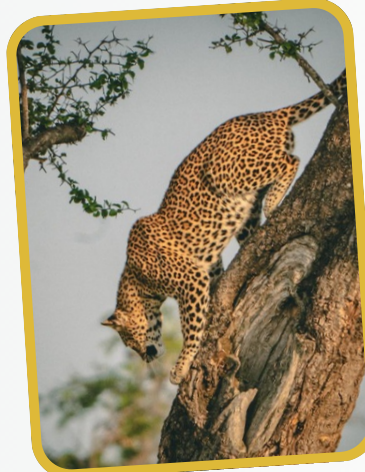
The Kruger is home to:

Securing Your Dates

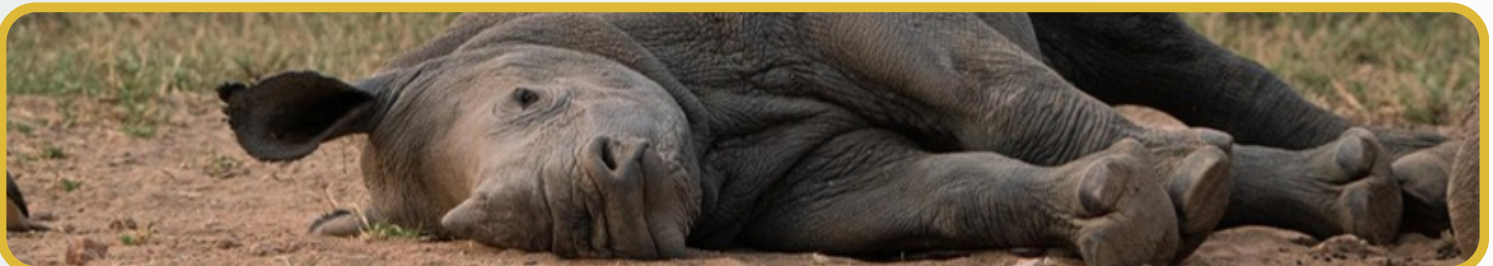
Deposit: 50% on acceptance

- These experiences book fast – early commitment ensures your preferred dates

Final Payment: Balance payable 14 days before arrival.

Cancellation Policy:

- More than a month before arrival: 50 % of all fees paid refunded
- More than 2 weeks before arrival: 25% of all fees paid refunded
- Less than 2 weeks before arrival: NO REFUND
