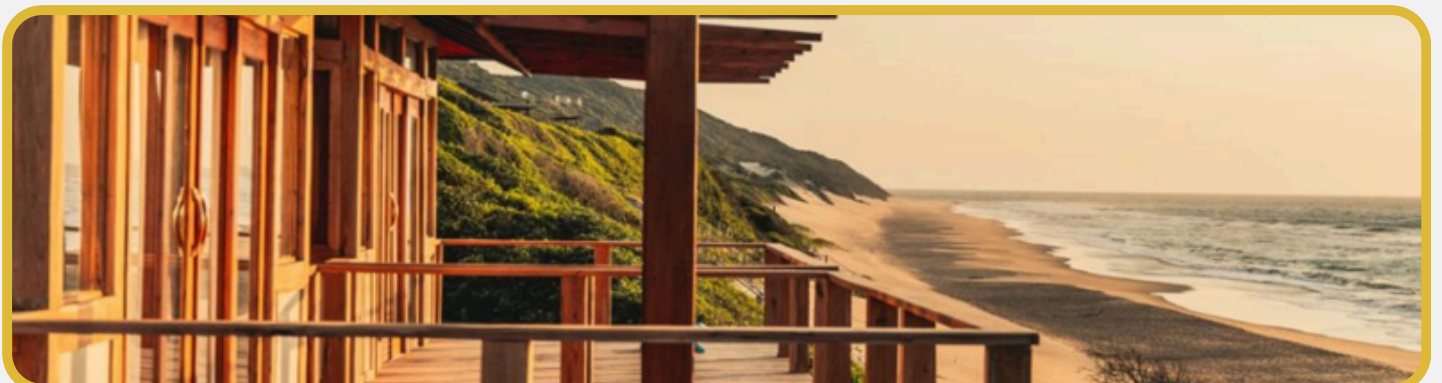

Important Notes

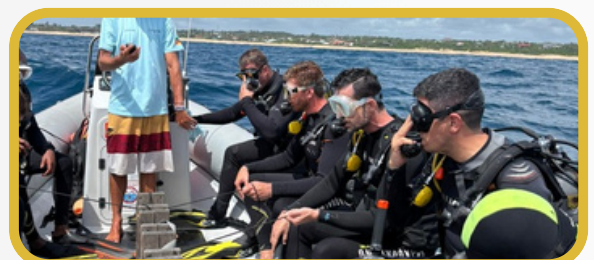
- Your guide will be your main source of transport and support from start to finish
- Designed around groups of 8 guests sharing for optimal value
- Smaller or larger private groups can be accommodated on request
- Pickup and departure locations can be adjusted depending on your travel plans

- A child sharing rate is applicable from 2-17-year-olds when accommodated in family tents with two full-paying adults.
- A maximum of two children are accommodated per family tent.
- An exclusive-use vehicle is required on bookings with children under the age of 5 (when at Pafuri).

Kruger National Park

Chapter 1 & 3

The journey starts at Skukuza Rest Camp within the Kruger National Park, with two days spent travelling North towards Pafuri and a further two days exploring the park on our return South following our stay in this remote wilderness area.

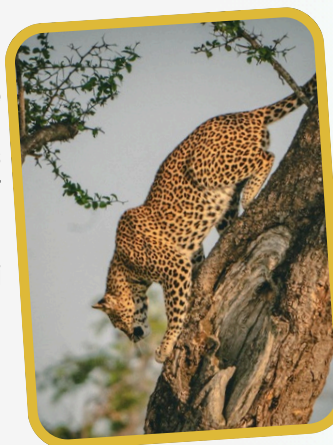
Widely regarded as one of Africa's premier safari destinations, this region offers:

Game drives are conducted in a private open safari vehicle, allowing your guide to adapt each day according to wildlife movement, weather conditions, and guest interests.

Kruger Accommodation

3 Nights

Within the Kruger National Park, guests stay at rest camps strategically positioned to maximise wildlife viewing opportunities and safari flow.

Accommodation is comfortable, practical, and intentionally focused on keeping guests immersed in the wilderness.

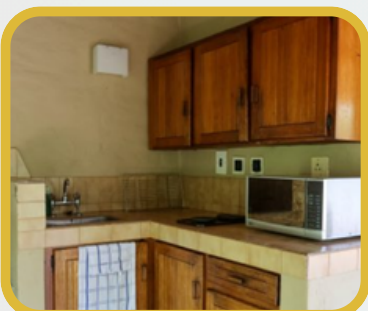
Guests can expect:

Located within the remote Makuleke Contractual Park in the far North of the Kruger, Pafuri offers a completely different safari experience.

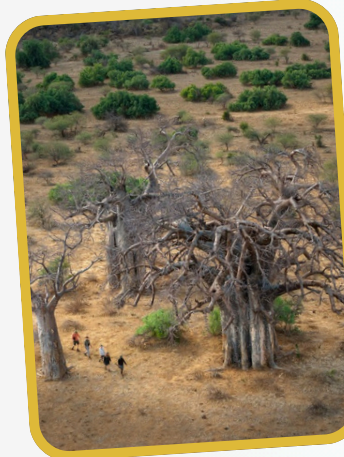
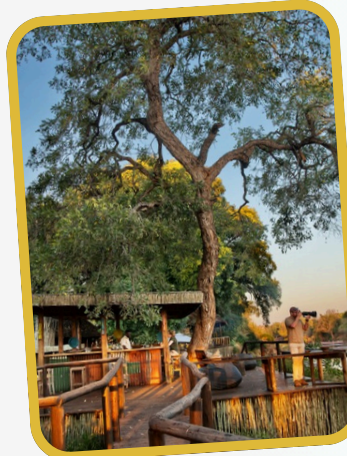
The region is defined by:

- Ancient baobab trees
- The Luvuvhu River
- Exceptional birdlife
- Low visitor numbers
- Rich ecological diversity
- World-renowned walking safaris

The 26,500-hectare concession is a living tapestry, ever-shifting with the seasons.

Though it covers just 1% of Kruger National Park, Pafuri holds an astonishing 75% of its biodiversity, making it one of the richest corners of this wildness.

Whether you begin your day with the thrill of a morning game drive or a peaceful, guided bush walk (by prior arrangement), here, the rhythm of nature leads the way. Spend your afternoon cooling off in the pool or sipping something refreshing at the bar, all to the soundtrack of birdcall and rustling leaves.



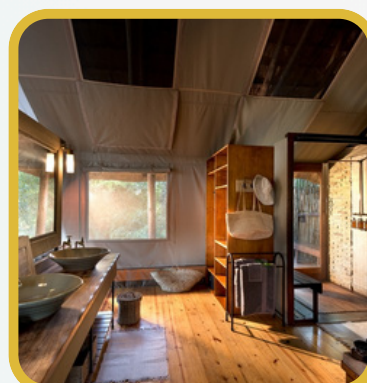
Pafuri Camp Accommodation

Cradled beneath towering trees along the banks of the Luvuvhu River, where the Makuleke Contract Park meets the Northern Kruger, Pafuri Camp offers an enchanting retreat into untamed Southern Africa.

Every detail at Pafuri Camp is designed to offer serenity, connection, and the simple pleasures of safari living.



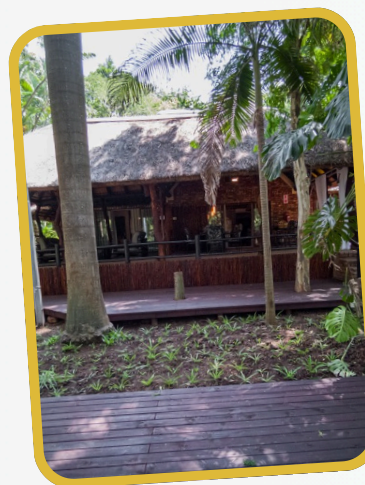
Marloth Park

The Bridge

Bordering the Kruger National Park, Marloth Park is a unique conservation area where wildlife roams freely and the bush experience continues long after the safari drive ends. Its convenient location between Kruger and Mozambique makes it the perfect overnight stop before and after our border crossings, ensuring a relaxed pace and a smooth transition between destinations.

What makes Marloth Park special:

- Directly borders Kruger National Park along the Crocodile River
- Approximately 35 minutes from the Mozambican border
- Free-roaming wildlife and exceptional birdlife throughout the reserve
- A peaceful bush setting that complements the safari experience and breaks up longer travel days nicely

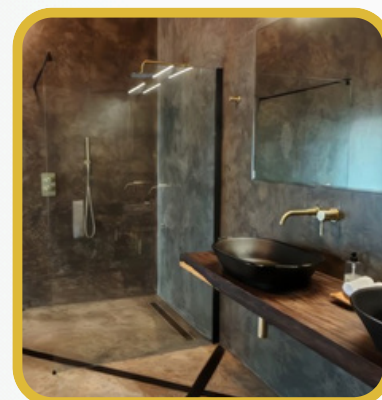
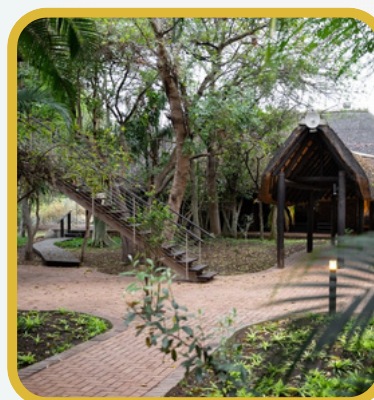


Marloth Accommodation

Chapter 4

After days immersed in the bush, the journey shifts to the Mozambican coast, where the rhythm changes completely.

Ponta Malongane lies along a pristine stretch of coastline within the **protected Ponta do Ouro Partial Marine Reserve**.

Here, forest meets ocean, and life moves with the tides rather than tracks. This is the counterbalance to safari days, offering contrast, release, and a second ecosystem to explore.

The experience naturally shifts from land to sea, with time to slow down and take in the coastal surroundings.



What makes Ponta Malongane exceptional:

- Warm Indian Ocean waters and protected coral reef systems
- Rich marine life and diverse ocean activities
- A vibrant coastal atmosphere, with local restaurants, nightlife, and craft markets

Ponta Malongane Accommodation

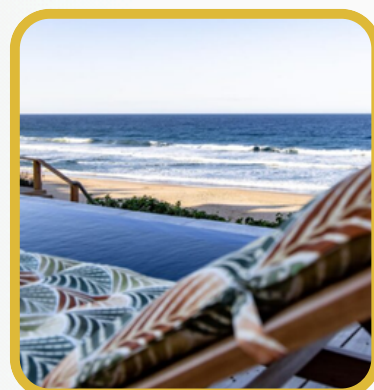

Securing Your Dates

- Confirmation: To secure the spot, a 35% refundable deposit is required.
- Commitment Fee: If another guest wants the same dates, you'll be asked to convert that deposit into a 35% non-refundable commitment fee to keep the booking.
- Final Payment: The balance must be paid 60 days before arrival.

Late Payment Penalty: If the balance isn't settled on time, a 3% penalty of the total value is added, compounded every week it remains outstanding.

Cancellation Policy:

Cancellations must be sent in writing. The fees are as follows:

- No Commitment Fee Paid: No cancellation fees apply.
- Commitment Fee or Full Payment Received:
 - Cancelled between confirmation and 61 days prior: The 35% commitment fee is forfeited.
 - Cancelled 60 days or less prior: The full reservation value is forfeited.
 - Refunds: Any qualifying refund is subject to a 5% handling fee
